THE RED FLAGS RULE “REALITY CHECK”

Don't let delayed enforcement dates distract you from the reality of the Red Flags Rule. While it's intended to protect the public and your dealership from ID thieves, not complying carries an even bigger price. Not having an identity theft prevention program means putting your dealership at unnecessary financial risk – and at a distinct competitive *disadvantage*.

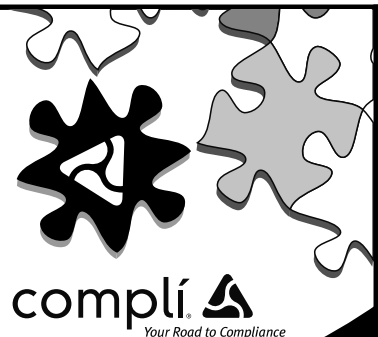
